

Delaware State Referee Committee (SRC) / HOSTING AN ENTRY LEVEL CLINIC

Thank you for your interest in hosting a new referee on-field clinic. Below is information on the Delaware SRC's process to host entry level clinics. Topics covered include:

- General information
- Hosting requirements
- Request to host an entry level clinic

GENERAL INFORMATION

- The process includes candidate registration, payment, online requirements/training in US Soccer's Learning Center, Delaware SRC webinar, followed by an in-person field session at the hosting organization's venue, lasting approximately 4 hours.
- Candidates MUST complete all pre-clinic items in the Learning Center and the SRC webinar 48 hours prior to the clinic in order to participate in the on-field session. Candidates MUST be present for the full duration of both the webinar and on-field sessions.
- The SRC will manage candidate registration and pre-clinic activities in the Learning Center, facilitate the webinar training sessions, and provide instructor/mentor resources for the field sessions.

Organizations can contact the SRC to make application to host an in-person field clinic. The hosting organization MUST agree to the hosting requirements and appoint a representative whose responsibility will be to facilitate meeting them. The minimum number of candidates needed to hold a clinic is 6.

DSRA REQUIREMENTS TO HOST AN ENTRY LEVEL REFEREE CLINIC

- Host organization appoints a Representative.
- The Representative reserves a soccer field.
 - Field may be indoor or outdoor; any size; ¼, ½, or full, but must be suitable to accommodate the number of candidates.
 - Field must be available for 4 consecutive hours, any date/time.
 - Proof of reservation MUST be provided to the instructor.
- Representative MUST be present at the beginning of the field session to meet the instructor, provide proof of field reservation and ensure its accessibility/safety.
- Enrollment
 - Maximum no. of candidates: 16
 - Minimum no. of candidates: 6
- Cancellation policy: field session will be cancelled due to inclement weather or lack of minimum no. of candidates.
 - New Request to Host Form must be submitted, and candidates registered for the cancelled field session will have priority.

REQUEST TO HOST AN ENTRY LEVEL CLINIC

- Representative submits a ***Request to Host Form*** to the SRC.
 - SRC must receive request 30 days prior to requested date.
 - Requests reviewed in order by date received.
 - Application to host status will be posted on the DSRA website ***Clinic Dates*** page.
